Directions to Camp

Camp Pinetreat is located north of I-65 at Exit #37, five miles north of Bay Minette, AL. If driving from Mobile, exit #37 and turn left. Pine Treat Road is the first street on the left. Look for the signs.

Check-In and Check-Out

Check-in for Teen Leadership, Night Owls and Journey is at 4:00p.m. on Sunday afternoons.

Check-in for Footsteps is at 4:00p.m. on Wednesday afternoon.

Check-out for all camps are between 4:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. on Friday afternoons.

Suggestion: Closed-toe and heel shoes are required. Please make sure your camper arrives in Tennis Shoes or something similar. Due to the running, playing, and hiking at camp, "Croc-type" shoes should not be worn.

What To Bring: *Invite a friend to Camp!*

Please put the camper's name on all clothes and belongings.

Skirts are **not** appropriate camp-wear

Tanktops must have at least 1 inch straps – spaghetti-type straps are not acceptable

One piece bathing suits are strongly recommended. Girls wearing revealing two-piece bathing suits will be asked to wear a t-shirt.

What Not To Bring

The following items are **not allowed** at Camp Pinetreat:

Radios, CD players and MP3 players

Video games and portable DVD players

Cell phones and pagers

Candy or snacks of any kind (these attract unwanted critters)

Camp Policy

No pocket knives, weapons of any type, alcoholic beverages, cigarettes or illegal drugs may be brought on the campsite. Anyone in violation of this policy will be sent home immediately.

Visitors and Phone Calls

For the security of the campers, camp is closed to all visitors during camp sessions. If you need to pick your child up early, please notify the director at check-in.

Campers are not allowed to make phone calls from camp. There is only one phone and it is for emergency use only.

Letters sent to campers can “make or break” a camp experience. Please keep news light and cheerful. Telling a camper about the fun trips he/she’s missed or how much the family pet is missing the camper will add to any feeling of homesickness. It is helpful to staff if you do NOT tell your child you’ll come get him/her immediately if he/she is homesick. We work with the campers to develop independence. Packages of games, books or cards are fine but please do NOT send candy or gum.

Medications

All medications must be given to the Camp Nurse or Camp Director at Check-In. Prescriptions must be labeled with camper’s name, doctor’s name, name of drug and dosage, and in their original container(s). Over-the-counter medications must also be labeled with the camper’s name and dosage. NO MEDICATIONS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE CAMPER’S LIVING AREA, EXCEPT ASTHMA INHALERS.

The Camp Nurse or Camp Director will administer all medications.

Snacks

For Teen Leadership and Night Owls, snacks are available for purchase throughout the week. \$10 per camper is sufficient.

For Journey and Footsteps, a nutritious daily snack is provided free of charge.
